Teaching

Teacher training (secondary level I and II):

- **Bachelor:**
 - Lecture: Principles of inclusive education
 - Seminar: Internship in pedagogic-psychological fields (no internship in teaching)

→ for all teacher trainees (secondary level I & II), approx. 200-300 persons per semester

→ internship also abroad
- **Master:**
 - Lecture & Seminar: Dealing with individual learning conditions in schools

→ only teacher trainees for secondary level I, approx. 40-50 persons per semester
- Further classes in Master of Education

Multidimensional Heterogeneity in the Classroom: Measurement, Effects, Mechanisms (MuHiK project)

Main research questions:

- Measurement:* Are approaches to measure multidimensional heterogeneity transferable to the classroom context and do they contribute to explaining differences in student achievement and psychosocial outcomes?
- Effects:* How is multidimensional heterogeneity related to student achievement as well as psychosocial outcomes?
- Mechanisms:* Which process characteristics at the level of teachers and peers can explain effects of multidimensional heterogeneity?

Future Research

School development projects – dealing with multidimensional heterogeneity

- Network of schools
- Perception of and dealing with heterogeneity
- Their needs for development

- Long-run:
 - Network of researchers and stakeholders in educational practice: develop and evaluate approaches of school development
